Spiritual Battle

Minnesota Shooter was a lost soul.

Gary Bauer's daily newsletter arrived Friday August 29th. It featured a discussion on the shootings of the children at the church in Minneapolis Mn. One of the main points that Gary made was the fact that the shooter in this hate crime was a transgender man who used a picture of Jesus for target practice.

My pastor, Bob Rogers also mentioned on Sunday August 31st that transgender men are often shooters of children at schools and churches. He gave about a dozen examples of shootings of children, and almost all of the shooters were transgender men (men who are trying to pretend they are women).

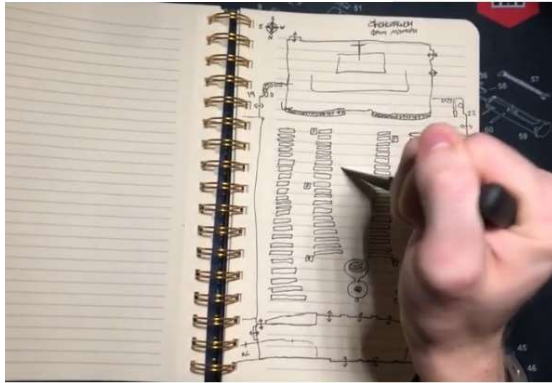
I next did a search on the internet with Google to try to confirm that mass shooting of children are often done by transgender men. Google had a short paragraph about transgender men being the shooter. The Google articles said that some people thought that transgender men were frequently the shooters in mass shooting of children, but then Google changed their thinking and denied that transgender men were often the shooters. Apparently, left wingers (like the people who write for Google) do not want the public to know that transgender men are often the shooters in school shootings.

The shooter was Robin Westman who was 23 yrs old and a former student at the same school. He was a transman who tried to pretend to be a woman. He shot and killed two young students thru the church window, because the church door had been locked by the church fathers so that he could not get into the church. He also wounded 14 other people, including 3 adults. Finally, Robin fatally shot himself.

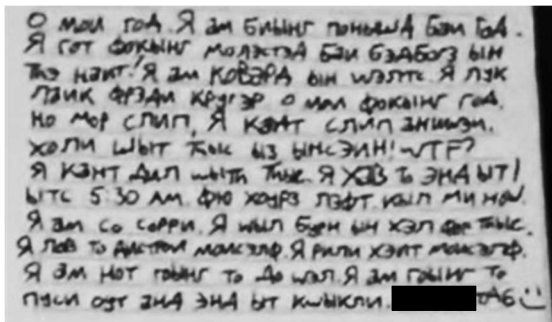

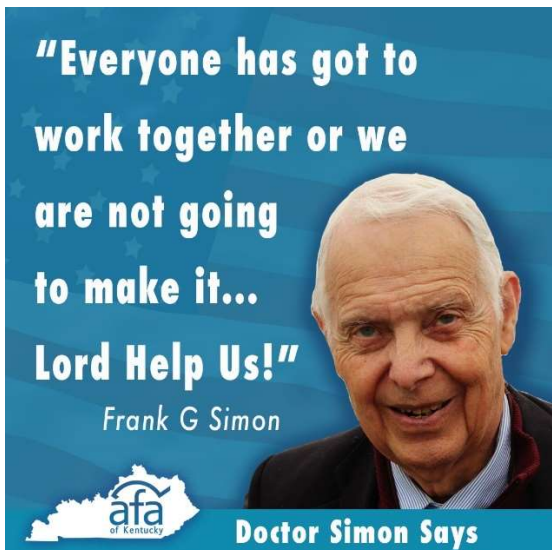


***I've come to the point where I just can't do this anymore. I tried—I really did. But something shifted, and now everything feels different. What I thought I understood, what I believed in... it doesn't hold up anymore.

I kept hoping things would change, that maybe you'd see things the way I do. But I can't keep waiting. I need to move forward, even if it hurts.

This isn't about blame. It's about clarity. I finally see things for what they are, not what I wanted them to be.

I hope you understand. I'm not angry—I'm just done.***



This whole tragic incident confirms that we are in a cultural war, and that there are people in America like Robin Westman that are confused and actually hate God and hate children.

That is why we all need to work together and grow our movement.

Robin left a diary which indicated that he was very depressed and was considering suicide. He seemed to indicate that the thought that trying to transition to being a girl would solve all his troubles. He was very disappointed that his unsuccessful attempt to become a girl didn't bring him peace and happiness. The left-wing press kept Robin's diary and writings a secret. We got copies of them from Alex Jones who is a conservative commentator.

Robin also left a video in which he forcefully plunged a knife into a picture of his church. The very severe hate he had for his church suggests the possibility that he might have been abused by his church (see picture to the top left).

Another interesting point that was revealed by Alex Jones is that he had President Trump's name on one of his guns as though Robin planned to try to shoot the president too.

Another picture released by Alex Jones said "6 million wasn't enough". This may have been implying that the 6 million Jews killed by Hitler was not enough killing of Jews and that he wanted to kill more Jews.

Another thing that impressed me as I read Robin's diary is how much he apologized to his family (parents, two sisters, and five brothers) for the trouble they would go through because of his shooting of the children at the school.

The final point that I want to mention is a picture that was released with Robin's diary. It showed him looking into a mirror and the image of him that showed in the mirror was a demon with horns (see second picture to the left).

This whole tragic shooting incident confirms that we are in a cultural war and that there are people in America like Robin who are confused about God and try to take it out on children and other groups.

That is why we all need to work together and try to help people who are confused and turn our schools and country back to God.

For example, Kentucky Family Association helped Kentucky pass House Bill 495 which prevents children from gender conversion (mutilation and cross sex hormones). This kind of bill in Minnesota would have helped Robin.

The Texas version of the bill to put the Ten Commandments into public school classrooms is moving forward.

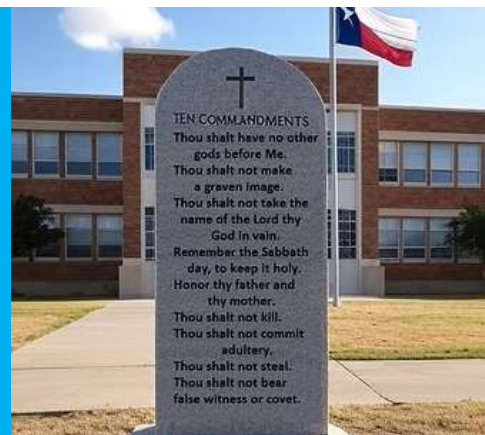

Building Support for the Baby Olivia Act

Earlier this year during legislative season, we encouraged our supporters to email their state legislators to pass the Baby Olivia Act. That legislation would require our public schools to show a video or ultrasound display of the development of a baby in the womb, for health class or sex. ed. class.



So then, why should we pass the Baby Olivia Act? Several studies have shown that some women, once they see an ultrasound of their baby, decide to keep their baby rather than choosing abortion. So, imagery in the classroom of the development of the baby in the womb should reinforce the inclination to choose life for the unborn. We believe that these videos and ultrasounds will encourage a culture of life in Kentucky's next generation while educating students on human anatomy and development.

Many young ladies in Kentucky are not getting that education on human development.

"I have worked with many young women who were participating in the HANDS

program in Kentucky," our supporter Carolyn wrote, "[I] was amazed by how many had not been educated about their baby's development in the womb. They were always amazed to see pictures of babies in the womb, especially their own baby's development."

In 2024, the Baby Olivia Act had only 8 cosponsors in the state legislature. Thanks to our work and the work of like-minded organizations in Kentucky, we ended up with 28 cosponsors in 2025 (the most cosponsors of any legislation sent to the House Education Committee this year). Unfortunately, the Baby Olivia Act didn't get a vote in committee. So, we launched a petition campaign for the Baby Olivia Act to show legislators the public support for it during the 2026 session.

So far this year, more than 480 of our supporters have signed a Baby Olivia Act petition or emailed a state legislator to encourage him or her to vote for the Baby Olivia Act. People from across the Commonwealth have signed on or emailed, including from Ashland, Calvert City, Crestwood, Elizabethtown, Florence, Frankfort, Kevil, La Grange, Lexington, Louisville, Mayfield, Nicholasville, Owensboro, Paducah, and Shepherdsville.
